We are seeking a level II /IODA Dental Assistant to join our team for a temporary clinical skills lab instructor position, with potential for ongoing continuance afterwards.

Hours required: 11am-4 pm, Monday-Friday.

Instructor Duties include:

Instruction to dental assisting students in the clinical, practical component. Skills practices to supervise are the following:

- (1) application and removal of rubber dam;
- (2) mechanical polishing of the coronal portion of the teeth, but not including any instrumentation.
- (4) taking alginate impressions of the teeth for study and working models.
- (6) oral hygiene instruction & dietary counselling relative to dentistry;
- (8) fluoride application;
- (9) application of materials topically to prepare the surface of the teeth for pit and fissure sealants;
- (10) application of pit and fissure sealants;
- (11) application of topical anesthetics;

- (12) application of desensitizing agents;
- (13) polishing restorations;
- (14) oral irrigation;
- (15) whitening the coronal portion of the teeth using tray-based systems and materials generally available to the public without prescription;
- (16) placing and removing restorative matrix bands and wedges;
- (17) public health screenings to detect gross abnormalities
- (18) removing periodontal dressings that are uncomplicated and
- (19) removing simple interrupted sutures

Minimum experience:

1) 4 years as a Dental Assistant

OR

2) 2 years as a Dental Assistant

AND (*any one of the following*)

Hold a bachelor's degree from a Canadian University or an equivalent degree.

OR

A graduate of a College of Applied Arts and Science
